We are seeking dedicated volunteer translators to support us by translating educational and informational content into and from Afghan languages (English, Farsi, Pashto, Uzbeki, Pashae, Baluchi, and more). Volunteers will play a critical role in making high-quality learning resources accessible to diverse audiences.

Job Duties:

- Translate written materials accurately and culturally appropriately
- Work with educational content such as books, articles, and lesson materials
- Collaborate with the Darakht-e Danesh team to meet project timelines
- Review and revise translations as needed

Qualifications:

- Fluency in English and at least one of the following languages: Farsi, Pashto, Uzbeki, Pashae, Baluchi, or any other Afghanistan language
- Ability to translate English into Farsi/Dari, Pashto and/or translate from Farsi/Dari into Pashto and/or other Afghanistan languages
- Strong written communication skills in both source and target languages
- Attention to detail and commitment to accuracy

Preferred:

- Prior translation experience is an asset but not required
