Job Description:

Volunteers needed to lead "Joy" activities as part of the Darakht-e Danesh Classroom Joy of Teaching Summit. Volunteers will host one hour sessions, leading approximately 30 teachers through yoga practices.

Job Duties:

- Create practical yoga strategies to share with approximately 30 teachers
- Provide information on yoga practices for teachers to utilize

Qualifications:

- Experience leading group yoga classes (virtually)
- Ability to guide participants through poses, breathwork, and relaxation techniques
- Knowledge of basic anatomy and injury prevention
- Strong communication skills and a welcoming, inclusive teaching style
- Commitment to creating a safe, respectful, and supportive environment for all participants

Preferred:

- Experience teaching beginner-friendly or mixed-level classes
- Familiarity with inclusive and accessible yoga practices
- Experience guiding yoga practices virtually
- Openness to aligning the class with the organization's mission and values
