Volunteer Tutor: Subject Matter Expert (Virtual)**

Job Description:

The Volunteer tutor will play an essential role in supporting Afghan students in grades 7 to 10 to improve their secondary school level skills, with a focus on helping students successfully transition to an International school curriculum. Tutors might be retired educators, college or university students, or other dedicated members of the public with teaching experience.

Volunteer tutors with experience teaching English, math and science subjects would work online with students in small groups (5-15 students) to provide subject-specific tutoring support and encouragement to help advance their skills. The aim is to create a safe space and active learning environment for students to review current lessons or recent assignments and assessment results and practice problem solving and comprehension skills in a collaborative format.

Job Duties:

- Host a weekly subject specific tutoring session focusing on the (Afghan/Canadian) grade 7-10 curriculum (list of topics and supportive learning materials will be provided)
- Create weekly lesson plans based on student goals
- Facilitate group discussions and interactive activities to encourage active participation
- Model and maintain professional communication practices
- Provide constructive feedback to students to help them improve their confidence and skills
- Create a supportive and inspiring environment to encourage students to express themselves
- Maintain updated records of students' progress and attendance, and report any concerns or challenges to the DDC and TPD Coordinator

Qualifications:

- Proficiency in English (plus Dari and/or Pashto languages would be a benefit), both spoken and written
- Experience in teaching, tutoring subject specific learning sessions, especially with students from diverse cultural backgrounds
- Sensitivity to the cultural and educational backgrounds of Afghan students, with a willingness to adapt teaching methods accordingly
- Strong interpersonal skills and the ability to communicate effectively with students of varying levels
- Patience and enthusiasm for working with young learners
- Knowledge, skill and ability to review and mark grade 7-10 subject specific assignments
- Flexibility and availability to commit to regular weekly sessions, from between 1.5-3 hours per week for a period of 6 months
