Job Description:

The Volunteer English Conversation Club Facilitator will play a critical role in assisting Afghan female students in grades 8 to 10 to improve their English language skills, with a specific focus on successfully transitioning to a Canadian school curriculum.

The aim is to create a supportive environment for students to practice conversational English, enhance their comprehension, and build confidence in English communication.

Job Duties:

- Plan and prepare weekly conversational sessions focusing on Canadian curriculum (list of topics and supportive learning materials provided)
- Upload any resources used in the session, or to support student study to our LMS
- Facilitate group discussions and interactive activities to encourage active participation and language practice
- Provide constructive feedback to students to help them improve their pronunciation, grammar, vocabulary, and overall language proficiency
- Create a supportive and inspiring environment to encourage students to express themselves in English
- Collaborate with other volunteers to share best practices, identify areas for improvement and implement effective teaching strategies
- Maintain updated records of students' progress and attendance and report any concerns or challenges to the Conversation Club Liaison

Qualifications:

- Proficiency in English language both spoken and written
- Experience in teaching, tutoring, or facilitating English language learning sessions,

especially with students from diverse cultural backgrounds

- Sensitivity to the cultural and educational backgrounds of Afghan students, with a willingness to adapt teaching methods accordingly
- Strong interpersonal skills and the ability to communicate effectively with students of varying English proficiency levels
- Patience and enthusiasm for working with young learners in a volunteer capacity
- Flexibility and availability to commit to regular sessions, typically held once a week (60 minutes) for a period of 6-8 months
